**GENERAL RULES, REGULATIONS AND INFORMATION
SEPARATE FINAL DIVISIONS FOR BOYS & GIRLS**

- 1) The 33rd ANNUAL COLORADO SPRINGS JUNIOR MASTERS MEMORIAL TOURNAMENT (DEDICATED TO MARTHA ALLIN AND RUTH SKELTON) will be conducted on August 14th and August 15th, 2010. Qualifying will be at Harmony Bowl on August 14th at 9:00 AM and at Peak Bowl Bowl at 1:00 PM with finals at Brunswick Zone on the 15th of August, 2010. **It is open to any bowler who has not attained the age of 20 as of 1 August 2010**, and who does not hold an USBC Adult membership. Non-USBC bowlers must pay a \$2.00 participation fee. Entries close 1/2 hour prior to squad time, providing space is available. Check in will be 8:30 AM on Saturday, August 14th at Harmony Bowl. Reservations are recommended and can be made by calling Kathleen Suhar at 719-597-5979 or Monte Hunter at 719-380-7669 by August 9th (Leave Message). You may also email reservations to ksuhar@comcast.net.
- 2) Entry fee will be \$55.00. Bowling fee - \$30.00, Expense fee - \$1.00, Prize fund - \$24.00. Prize fund will be returned 100%. No refunds will be given once entries close. If sufficient funds are available, more awards may be disbursed at the discretion of the tournament manager. Prize distribution is as follows:
 - a) Two \$500.00 scholarships will be awarded (based on 96 entries) with a minimum of one \$100.00 scholarship guaranteed in each Division. Scholarships will be administered through USBC SMART.
 - b) 2nd Through 4th Place: Choice of Plaque or \$25.00 Scholarship for both Divisions.
 - c) Highest qualifying game (1st 10 games): Choice of plaque or \$25.00 scholarship both Divisions.
- 3) The qualifying competition, which begins at 9:00 AM and 1:00 PM, Saturday August 14th will consist of 5 games across 10 lanes at each center. This competition will determine the qualifiers: 16 in the Open Division and 16 in the Classified Division, with an alternate in each Division. Classified Division will be 189 average and under, Open Division 190 and above. Contestants will be allowed 10 minutes practice. In the event of a tie, a one game roll off will be held.
- 4) Final Competition at Brunswick Zone will begin at 9:00 AM Sunday, August 15th.
- 5) After the opening matches, pairing and lane assignments will be in accordance with the normal BRACKET SYSTEM consisting of a two (2) game match. This will be displayed in the tournament center. The double elimination method of competition requires a participant to lose twice before being eliminated. The tournament manager, prior to the start of bowling, will accomplish any changes or byes required with the bracket system. All players start in the WINNERS BRACKET. After losing one match, the bowler enters the LOSERS BRACKET. In the finals on Sunday, the undefeated survivor of the WINNERS BRACKET will be matched against the winner of the LOSERS BRACKET, whose record will show only one defeat. If the bowler from the WINNERS BRACKET wins the first match, he/she will be the TOURNAMENT CHAMPION. A victory for the bowler(s) from the LOSERS BRACKET would tie the two finalists at one defeat and require them to bowl a second match for the championship.
- 6) If a bowler is unable to appear for the first round of the finals, the alternate will be given the opportunity to replace him/her in the schedule. After the first round, NO SUBSTITUTES OR ALTERNATES WILL BE PERMITTED. Nonappearance, regardless of cause, will constitute forfeiture of the match and the player present will bowl his/her games without opposition, to advance to succeeding rounds. If forfeiture occurs in the WINNERS BRACKET, the absent player will automatically go into the appropriate position in the LOSERS BRACKET.
- 7) If a tie occurs, each contestant will bowl one game. If a tie still exists, a 9th and 10th frame roll-off will occur until the tie is broken.
- 8) Any protest with the tournament will be in accordance with USBC rule 329.
- 9) **ALL PARTICIPANTS MUST WEAR SLACKS AND COLLARED SHIRTS NO CAPS, TANK-TOPS OR HALTER-TOPS.**
- 10) **USBC Rule 400 will be enforced.**
- 11) **Any matters not covered by these rules will be governed by USBC.**
- 12) **NO FOOD OR DRINKS IN THE SETTEE AREA. NO TOBACCO PRODUCTS WILL BE USED DURING THE TOURNAMENT.**
