 - C. Bowling ability - high average, game, series, etc.
 - D. Any special honors or achievements (local, state, national)
3. Numbers of years nominee has participated in youth leagues.
4. Participation in high school activities, clubs, sports, honors, etc.
5. General attitude - cooperation and ability to get along with others.
6. Community involvement.
7. Work history.
8. Plans for the future.
